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PROGRESS ON NAHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE INTERIM MEETING 2022 ACTION ITEMS

Item	Description	Who	When	Status
1	Develop figures showing feral animal investigations for inclusion in the status report going forward (continued from 2021).	WHA and AHA	May 2023	Completed. See status report.
2	Discuss reporting lines for feral animal surveillance data (continued from 2021).	NAQS, WHA and AHA	May 2023	Ongoing. Links to APC data standards.
3	Consult with jurisdictions to identify current JEV reporting issues to ensure that JEV reporting into NAHIP is consistent with national case definitions.	AHA	February 2023	Superseded. The issue of a national case definition for JEV went to AHC, led by NSW, however, AHC has not yet agreed to a consistent case definition for JEV.
4	Develop recommendations on reporting of inconclusive JEV results into NAHIP as part of broader consideration of the national process of reporting inconclusive results.	AHA	February 2023	Ongoing. To be discussed later during this meeting within the data standards workshop.
5	Update the committee OOS on the outcome of the EAD Hotline AHC paper.	AHA	December 2022	Complete with this meeting. The recommendations from the EAD Hotline Review were endorsed by AHC in January 2023.
6	Seek clarity from AHC on where the responsibility for updating the EAD Hotline NASOP sits and to update the committee OOS.	AHA	February 2023	Completed. On SCEAD workplan: Stock-take of current NASOP's (EAD Resource Library) and identify NASOP gaps.
7	Send the draft AHIA interactive supplement link to committee members and CVOs for feedback.	AHA	November 2022	Completed. Not all CVOs supported the inclusion of an AHIA interactive supplement with the AHIA 2022 Report so although the interactive supplement was developed, it did not form a part of the report.

8	Provide the committee with the findings of DAFF's review of whether NAHIP data is sufficiently meeting DAFF's needs in relation to the program's goal of "supporting trade in animal commodities and meeting Australia's international reporting obligations".	DAFF	May 2023	Closed. AHA met with representatives of various branches of DAFF and discussed high level principles about DAFF's data needs in relation to trade and international reporting. This is helping to inform the APC data standards workshop.
9	Approach the sheep industry and DAFF OCVO and Exports Standards branch for NAHIP representatives.	AHA	December 2022	Completed. Sheep Industry representative now on the NAHIP Committee. AHA invited the additional DAFF members, however due to resourcing constraints, DAFF is unable to provide extra representation for NAHIP.
10	Share their draft Laboratory Test Standard document (provisional name for this document).	NSW	May 2023	Completed. Circulated and to be discussed during the workshop session of this meeting.
11	Update the committee on the process for data access requests.	AHA	November 2022	Completed.
